The Money Maker

How does Jane's father make money?

Jane's father makes dollar bills. He works for the government in Washington, D.C. and is called an **engraver**. It took him many years to learn his job.

He makes pictures on a **steel plate** by cutting thin lines into the plate with a very sharp tool. Other people work on the plates with him. For example, he does the faces while someone else does the letters.

When the plates are finished, they are put into a printing **press**. The plates are then covered with ink and pressed against large sheets of paper. This prints the pictures onto the paper.

The large sheets with many dollar bills printed on them are then cut up into single dollar bills.
